**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HORSE  
COMPETITORS**

1. DOGS: Dogs must be restrained at all times.
2. LUNGING: There will be NO lunging on the Main Arena and NO Double Lunging whatsoever.
3. CLOSING DATE: Entries close October 31st, 2022.  
All entries received after closing date will be considered LATE ENTRIES and charged at double entry fee, which must be paid before competitor can compete. Extra entries are taken on the day of the show at the Arena Office.
4. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE: Unless otherwise listed in the entry fee per class is \$5 for all horse events. Entry fee must accompany entries, otherwise entry will not be accepted. V.A.S. Ltd. Compulsory insurance (39 cents per entry) is included in the entry fee. A stamped self-addressed envelope must be included if receipt of entry is required.
5. TIMES: Times indicated are only an indication of expected starting times, and the Committee reserves the right to vary same.
6. SHOWGROUNDS CAMPING WITH HORSES: No entrant shall at any time camp on any of the show-grounds of the Societies which comprise the Gippsland Agricultural Societies' Association, without first obtaining permission from the Society concerned.
7. PROTESTS: No appeal against the decision of the judge will be entertained unless made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$50 and lodged with the Arena Manager within 60 minutes of the termination of the event in dispute. If the protest is found to be frivolous, the deposit will be forfeited.
8. MATTERS SUBJECT TO DISPUTE: The decision of the Ground Jury shall be final and binding. No decision so made shall be called into question by the entrant before any court or other body (whether or not of a similar nature to a court) whatsoever.
9. HORSES MUST BE CONTAINED IN YARDS.
10. ELECTRIC FENCES ARE NOT PERMITTED.

11. RANDOM DRUG TESTING: Random testing may be undertaken at this show as directed by the E.A. and under E.A. guidelines.
12. STALLIONS AND COLTS: Stallions and colts over the age of 18 months must be led with a proper head-stall and suitable bit and must be suitably restrained or yarded when not competing. Stallions and colts are ineligible for ridden classes except Show jumping, Working Stockhorse and/or special stallion classes.
13. SAFETY HELMETS: All riders must wear approved safety helmets to the current Australian, European or American standards, whilst competing and exercising.  
Australian Standard: **AS/NZS 3838** (2006 onwards) SAI marked  
**ARB HS 2012** – SAI global marked  
European Standard: **VGI (01.040: 201412)** with or without BSI Kitemark  
American Standard: **ASTMF1163** (2004a or 04a onwards) SAI Global marked or standard **SNELL E2001**.  
Current British standard **PAS 015** (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI kitemarked.  
If jumping, the helmet must be tagged with a current visible EA 'helmet tag' as per EA Article 256.  
**NO OTHER HEAD GEAR WILL BE PERMITTED. THE RETAINING HARNESS MUST BE SECURED AND FASTENED AT ALL TIMES. THIS RULE APPLIES TO ALL EVENTS.**
14. CHAMPIONSHIPS: Any horse winning a Ridden Championship in Ring 2 or 3 is ineligible to compete for another Ridden Championship in Ring 2 or 3 at this show. Any horse winning a Led Championship in ring 2 or 3 is ineligible to compete for another Led Championship in ring 2 or 3 at this show.
15. If a rider has a fall in a Class they are not allowed to remount in that class and are eliminated from that class. Jumping competitors must get a medical clearance to ride again that day.
