- All stallions and colts over 1 year of age must be bitted and a chain or bar lead attached.
- 2. Stallions and colts are ineligible for Open Classes.
- In awarding Champion, the winners or the relative classes will compete and the second placegetter to Champion will be eligible to compete for Reserve Champion.
- 4. Horse section tickets and Waivers will be available at the Stand on the Eastern side of the arena and in this program. Required for every ring.
- ALL competitors MUST complete a Waiver form prior to entering. To save time, download from the VicAgShow website with the program.
- Horses can only compete as either a Show Hunter or Open Horse not both.
- 7. All breeds must be registered with their relevant society and owners' members of that society. Registration papers and membership cards must be produced on request.
- 8. The committee reserve the right to alter the program.
- 9. The Judges and Committees decisions are final.
- All riding competitors must wear a current ASA approved helmet.
- 11. Classes will be held only if time permitting.
- 12. OTT series is open to all thoroughbreds, unraced or raced 4 years and over, over 14.2hh who are registered with RISA. Qualifying classes are judged ridden. A horse may only win one qualifier.
- Disputes committee Graeme Joiner, Janelle McDonald, Filipa Marshall
- 14. The use of tranquillisers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of animals is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under veterinary supervision.
- 15. It is expected that all judges, stewards and volunteers of the show society are to be treated with respect.
- 16. Good Hands Challenge Trophy Competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account. Special attention will be paid to

- hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband. A gear check may take place. Straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.
- 17. Alabar Hero Series Open to all purebred freeze branded Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number must be provided. All horses to be registered with Harness Racing Australia to be eligible. Riders to be 12 years and over on the day of the Qualifying Show. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another qualifier in that calendar year. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Alabar HERO Series Final to be held at VAS Saddle Horse Championships. Class to be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration Standardbred qualities conformation manners, paces and performance racing related injuries and or blemishes are permitted. The judge's decision is final.
- 18. Off the Track Led Series Open to any thoroughbred horse bred to race that has been studbook registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or Internationally that are 4 years and over and over 14.2 hands. Registrations will be checked by VAS office. Racing name to be used where appropriate. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another show qualifier in that calendar year. Qualifiers gain automatic entry into Racing Vic Off the Track Led Series Final to be held at VAS Saddle Horse Championships. Class to be judged as a good example of an Off the Track Thoroughbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration Thoroughbred qualities confirmation manners, paces and performance injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed. The judge's decision is final
- 19. Off the Track Ridden Series as above in rule 18. Riders to be 14 year and over on the day of the qualifying show.
