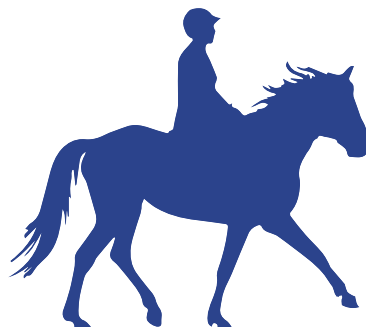

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- This event is open to members of clubs affiliated with the HRCV and will be conducted under HRCV rules and regs
- Membership & Showing Cards & Official HRCV entry Form to be handed in to Card Sec 30 mins before first class starts
- Classes may be combined/split if low/high entries. The Judge has the right to split/merge classes based on number of competitors
- Riders must supply their own number
- Riders must wear their club's registered colours, approved helmets, and footwear to be worn
- The decision of the ground jury is final
No secondary protests will be entered in to
- If medical attention is deemed necessary, an ambulance will be called at the rider's expense
- Protests must be lodged within 30 mins of interim results being posted and accompanied by a \$20 deposit
- All Classes count towards Highpoint. In the event of equal placing count back is based on the highest placing in the rider class (including Champion) shall determine a winner followed by ridden mount and MMS
- No refunds will be issued after the closing date unless a valid veterinary or doctor's certificate is provided within 14 days of the completion of the event. All refunds will have a \$10 admin fee deducted
- CVEC accepts no liability for injury, loss or damage to any person horse, property, or equipment
- HRCV extreme weather policy & horse welfare shall be observed, should weather conditions be unsuitable for running a safe event the Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel.

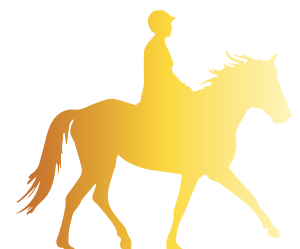
If there is a draw then there will be a count back based on number of first places, then if still a draw it will be decided on how many riders in the classes.
