HORSE RULES, GUIDELINES & GENERAL INFORMATION – 2023 SHOW SEASON

- 1. All entries and associated fees, including Stockman's Obstacle Challenge, to be taken to the Horse Ticket Office located at Arena Gate A
- Ticket Tent opens at 7am Show Day. <u>Please note</u>: Numbers system is being used (ie one number per horse to be written in column on entry form).
- 3. Entries will not be accepted unless the Official Horse Entry and Waiver Form have been completed and signed by the Exhibitor.
- 4. Please have your Entry and Waiver Form completed, prior to presenting at the Ticket Tent to avoid delays.
- 5. The Waiver Form must be signed/completed. If under the age of 18 years a Parent or Guardian must sign on your behalf. Any Exhibitor failing to sign the Waiver will forfeit any qualification/prize money. Name and address to be supplied. Please print clearly on Entry forms.
- 6. A competitor must choose to enter in classes as either <u>SHOW HUNTER</u> or <u>SHOW HORSE</u> but not enter both. Once a horse has competed as a Show Horse or Show Hunter at its first VAS Ltd. event in a calender year it must remain a Show Horse or Show Hunter at VAS Ltd.competitions for that Calendar Year. Once a horse has successfully won a Champion in its first <u>OPEN RING</u> it cannot continue to compete in the equivalent section in other OPEN RINGS. First place getters are eligible to compete in MULTIPLE OPEN RINGS until successful as a CHAMPION.
- A. The use of tranquilisers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance or behavior of animals, is strictly forbidden.
 B. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and testing of all animals is at the owner's risk.

C. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under veterinary supervision.

D. The attention of Exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to misuse of drugs, and that the Mansfield A & P Society may undertake random testing for forbidden substances.


- Safety: once judging has commenced only Exhibits being judged are permitted in the Arena. Children in pushers not permitted on Arena.
- 8. Horse Exhibitors may produce a current Height Certificate recognised by RAS, EV, VAS Ltd, SHCV or Affiliated Shows, to Stewards prior to Judging.
- 9. All Competitors enter entirely at their own risk. Ground Stewards have the power to evict horses not properly restrained on Showgrounds.
- **10.** Please don't affix baling twine or ties to posts, trees or rails..
- 11. All <u>Floats and Trucks</u> enter via Greenvale Lane .
- 12. <u>Where stated in the Program</u>: Exhibits must be registered with their respective Societies and Stud Books. Proof of registration may be requested.
- **13.** <u>Novice</u>: Not having won a Novice Class competing singularly at any agricultural show.
- 14. No Stallions allowed in Open Rings 1, 2 & 3
- 15. The Committee reserves the right to change or delete any class and reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without citing reasons for doing so.
- **16. Please note**: A rider falling from their horse in a Riding Class is not eligible to remount and continue in that Class, but may continue to compete in other Classes (but only if <u>cleared as fit to continue</u> by the First Aid official).
- 17. Approved helmets must be worn by all competitors, including Fancy Dress riders. If a Competitor enters the arena without a helmet, they will be asked to dismount immediately. This is the Rule of Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd. It is compulsory for everyone competing on a horse, working, schooling, or riding for any other reason at a Show or in any area considered to be part of the Showgrounds to wear a helmet. (Rule applies to all VASL Affiliated Agricultural Societies) Mansfield A & P Society is Affiliated with VASL.
- 18. When a class is age-restricted, eg. Smartest on Parade, Junior Riding Classes, and Children's Mounts, top boots or gaiters cannot be worn by a Competitor under the age of 18yrs.
- 19. Show rings are available for riders to warm up prior to events (from 6:00am). Arena must be cleared by 8.30 am no exceptions.
- 20. Classes will not be held up if an Exhibitor's other Classes clash. To avoid disappointment and missing your Class, marshall outside designated gates two to three Classes before your Class.
- 21. <u>Champion Winners</u> from Rings 1,2 & 3 are eligible to compete for Supreme Rider: Hack, Galloway, Pony and Hunter.
- Queries on Show Day: please address any queries or concerns to the Ringmaster
- 22. Champions and Reserve Champions in Open Rings 1,2 & 3 are eligible to compete at VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships January 2023.
- 23. <u>PONY CLUB RIDERS & PARENTS PLEASE NOTE</u>. Mounts must have <u>TWO CURRENT</u> Pony Club Rallies to be eligible to compete in Pony Club Classes run under PCV RULES. You must present your card to the Steward before entering the Class. If you do not present your card to the Ring Steward, you will not be allowed to ride in the Pony Club Ring. Please do not forget to have your Card updated and bring it with you to the Show.
