## **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. All competitors who are non-members of the MHC, will be required to sign an EA indemnity form and pay a \$20 fee to become a day member of the Mildura Horse Complex. All day members are accounted for within the MHC insurance policy and are therefore covered by our Public and Products Liability Insurance Policy. Riders will not be allowed to compete until this fee has been paid and the indemnity form signed. Proof of membership will be required. Weekend membership for individuals is available for \$30. Family Day membership is also available. \$20 for the first combination and \$10 for every combination there after. Family weekend membership is available at a flat rate of \$50.
- 2. Entries to be made on Nominate and will close on Tuesday the 25<sup>th</sup> of March at 11pm. No late entries will be accepted.
- No dogs allowed.
- 4. Intermediate: Not to have won a prize competing in that class or an open saddle class at any Royal Show.
- Newcomer: Not to have competed under saddle at any event/show before the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2021. Lead rein and miniature turnout classes are exempt.
- 6. A saddle horse, galloway or pony is defined as being three years of age or over.
- 7. The event will be held in accordance with the current EA Show Horse and Show Jumping rules (as amended).
- 8. Supreme Led Breed Exhibit to be judged at the completion of the led breed classes in rings 1 & 2 and events 1 12 in ring 3.
- 9. Supreme Ridden Breed Exhibit to be judged at the completion of the ridden breed classes in rings 1 & 2.
- 10. Horses that win Champion Ridden Mount will be ineligible to compete in a similar class in another ring.
- 11. Horses may only compete as an Open or Hunter exhibit, not both.
- 12. Horses that win Champion Open Saddle Mounts in rings 1 & 2 (excluding Show Hunters & Working Hunters) are eligible for Supreme Champion Ridden Open Exhibit.
- 13. Horses that win Champion Ridden Hunter Mount (including Working Hunters) in rings 1 & 2 are eligible for Supreme Champion Ridden Hunter Exhibit.
- 14. Champion Child's Mount to be held in Ring 1 on completion of Champion Ridden Newcomer.
- 15. Supreme Ridden Open Exhibit, Supreme Ridden Hunter Exhibit and Supreme Rider to be judged at the completion of Rings 1 & 2. To be held in that order.
- 16. All **stallions/colts** must be led or ridden by an adult 18 years or over. They may participate in breed classes and the western ring but not in saddle classes.
- 17. All horses competing in registered breed classes must be registered with the nominated society. Where applicable proof of registration MUST be produced on request.
- 18. Owners entering breed classes must be a current financial member of the respective breed society.
- 19. A horse and rider combination may compete in **only** 3 showjumping classes in ring 5. These must be selected from events 1 to 3 and 5 to 8. It does **not** include event 4, the Rescue Relay on Saturday. This is an additional class that may be attempted.
- 20. Height measurement obtained at a Royal Show or an official EA or SHC measuring day and recorded on EA or SHC registration papers is the only height valid for the current season. Horses must be shown at their recorded height.
- 21. Under no circumstances will any ring be held up.
- 22. All riders must wear ASSA approved helmets at all times and suitable footwear.
- 23. Top boots and gaiters may **not** be worn by riders under 18 years of age in rider or smartest on parade classes but maybe worn in other classes.
- 24. Judges decision is final.
- 25. Protests must be lodged in writing with the secretary within 30 minutes of the event being judged. A deposit of \$50 will be returned if the protest is upheld. If the protest is denied the fee will be forfeited.
- 26. No refunds will be given on unused tickets.
- 27. The committee has the right to alter, cancel, change or combine classes without prior notice to the competitors.
- 28. Mildura Horse Complex Inc. will not be held responsible for any injury, loss or damage to competitors, spectators, equipment or property.
- 29. Mildura Horse Complex Inc. will not be responsible for any accident through or by an exhibitor and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall not hold the Mildura Horse Complex responsible and indemnify against any legal proceedings arising from such accident.
- 30. Camping is available at the grounds. Cost is \$10 a night for powered sites. Stalls are available at \$10 per horse per night. Please be considerate and clean the stalls after using them. Manure trailers are located near the stalls. Please contact Hayley Willison, to book yards and powered/unpowered sites.
- 31. The purchase of event tickets indicates that you have read the above Rules and Regulations and agree to abide by them.
