The Nhill A & P Society Inc Committee is committed to providing a safe, healthy, and environmentally acceptable Showgrounds for all stakeholders.

We shall maintain an effective health and safety program so far as in practicable and endeavour to comply with all statutory and Common Law requirements.

All competitors and exhibitors have a “Duty of Care” to avoid exposing themselves or other people to unsafe situations that could lead to injury.

SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS/COMPETITORS/ATTENDEES

1. DUTY OF CARE

All competitors have a “Duty of Care” to avoid exposing themselves or other people to unsafe situations that could lead to injury. The “Duty of Care” extends to the prevention of damage to property.

2. DIRECTION OF NHILL AGRICULTURAL & PASTORAL SOCIETY INC.

Competitors must comply with any reasonable request of Nhill A & P Society Inc Committee representatives.

3. EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Emergency Information and maps showing Emergency Assembly Points located in the various animal pavilions and buildings. Competitors should be familiar with these plans.

4. FIRST AID

During the Nhill Show, First Aid services are provided.

5. EMERGENCY FACILITIES

Firefighting or other emergency equipment must not be removed or used for any other purpose. Missing or unserviceable equipment should be reported to the Administration immediately.

6. HAZARD & INCIDENT REPORTING

Competitors must notify the Area/Pavilion Supervisor or Administration immediately if any hazards are detected or incidents occur. Hazards or incidents are any situation that could result or has resulted in

- A. The injury, illness or death of any person
- B. The injury, illness or death of any animal
- C. The damage, destruction or loss of property.
- D. Fire
- E. Other

7. WASTE DISPOSAL

All waste, including liquids, must be disposed of responsibly. Storm drains must not be used for the disposal of waste.

8. HOUSEKEEPING

All areas must be kept in clean and tidy order with clearly defined and available access and exit routes, at all times. Buildup of combustible waste must be avoided.

9. SLIPS, TRIPS & FALLS

Care must be taken to minimize trip hazards and obstacles that people may walk into. Avoid laying unprotected cables or pipes on or above paths, walkways, or roads.

10. MEDIA COMMENTS

Media comments about matters involving the showgrounds is coordinated by the Administrator.

11. SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted inside buildings, within 10 meters of a building entrance, around combustibles, during public performances or while handling hazardous materials.

12. ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

- a) Competitors should supply their own Residual Circuit Device (RCD) “Safety Switch” for installation at each power outlet they use.
- b) Extension cords must be earthed, and all electrical appliances must be earthed or double-insulated. Appliances must be in a sound working order.
- c) All electrical leads and temporary electrical equipment **must** be tagged and tested.
- d) The use of double adapters is strictly prohibited. Power boards must be fitted with current overload protection.
- e) Radiant electric or gas heaters are prohibited.
- f) Light sockets must not be used for any other purpose than for lighting.
- g) No naked flame permitted.

Entries will be done via Event Secretary and close Tuesday 17th October at 9.00pm

Entry: \$15/horse and rider/handler combination, this gives unlimited entry into all eligible classes in all rings and includes a \$3/horse compulsory swabbing fee.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE MEMBERS OF NHILL A & P SOCIETY INC Equine Competitor Membership is \$15 per person, Family Membership is \$25 and includes 2 adults and their children under 16 years.

A wristband with a number will be given to each horse and rider/handler combination. Results will be recorded according to the numbers as allocated, so it is in each competitor's best interests to ensure that the correct number is shown to the steward at the time of competition.

Prizes: Ribbons to third, unless otherwise stated. All protests (or any protests) must be made in writing to the ring master.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- When you have won two qualifying events in one ring, you are requested **NOT** to compete in any more qualifying classes in that ring, for that horse. There have been extra classes added in each championship section to allow more competitors to gain their appropriate qualifications. You are welcome to compete in both rings, but once you win a championship, then that exhibit **MUST** retire.
- Local classes are open to riders that reside within the Hindmarsh and West Wimmera Shire Council.
- Stallions and colts must wear green ID discs and be handled by persons 18 years and over.

REMEMBER: We love this event. At this event Nhill A& P Society Inc asks that you respect the officials, judges, and your fellow competitors / attendee's. Bullying and or any unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. Nhill A&P Society Inc Committee has the right to remove **ANY** competitor or attendee who they deem has brought the event into disrepute, immediately, from the Nhill Showgrounds and if deemed necessary, banned from the Nhill Showgrounds in the future.

Medication control of horses may take place in accordance with the Equestrian Australia Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations (1st edition effective 5 April 2010 and updates) and the Equestrian Australia Medication Control System and Swabbing Policy (1 January 2015).

Random swabbing and horse registration checks may take place at any time. A \$3 swabbing fee per horse is to be paid by all entrants. Fees to be held by WASA in a special fund for the continuation of random annual swabbing at all Wimmera Shows.

This special class has been added to our schedule in memory of the late Amy Pilgrim, an accomplished young horsewoman and all-round beautiful soul whose life was tragically cut short on 13 September 2020. The winner will receive a trophy and rosette generously donated by the Pilgrim family. Amy was a familiar face at the Nhill Show from the time she was just a tiny tot on her pony in the Fun Ring. She went on to compete successfully across the pony club, HRCav, open, show hunter and breeds events on a number of different mounts over her show career, as well as turning her hand to many other disciplines. One of Amy's memorable show ring partnerships was with the lovely Standardbred Ballum Park Royal Maverick (Patrick). Amy and Patrick competed across the breeds and open rings, up to Royal level, proudly flying the flag for the Standardbred breed and the Amy Pilgrim Memorial Standardbred Challenge aims to continue Amy's legacy, taking into account some of the unique challenges faced by Standardbreds competing under saddle and encouraging Standardbred exhibitors to reach for the heights of excellence.

This class will be judged in two separate sections. Competitors will present mounted to the judge first for a set workout (there are two options, one with a right lead canter, the other with a left lead canter, detailed below), to be performed individually, they will then unsaddle and present in hand at completion of the ridden workouts.

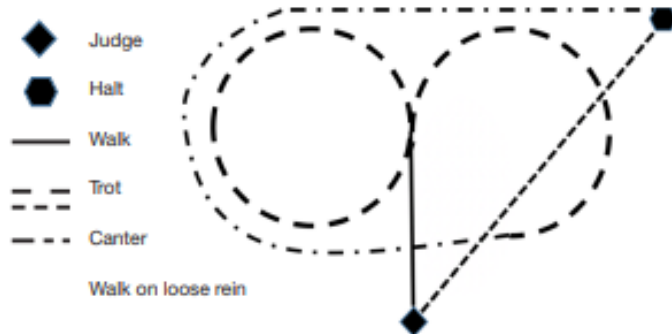
Points will be awarded for the following:

- Presentation, to be judged under saddle at commencement of the ridden workout (scored out of 20)
- Ridden workout, to be judged on accuracy of workout, manners and temperament, movement and quality (scored out of 60)
- In hand, judged on conformation, movement and quality (scored out of 20)
- An additional 5 bonus points will be awarded to horses that have competed in any class/es in Rings 1 & 2 on the day.

Option A

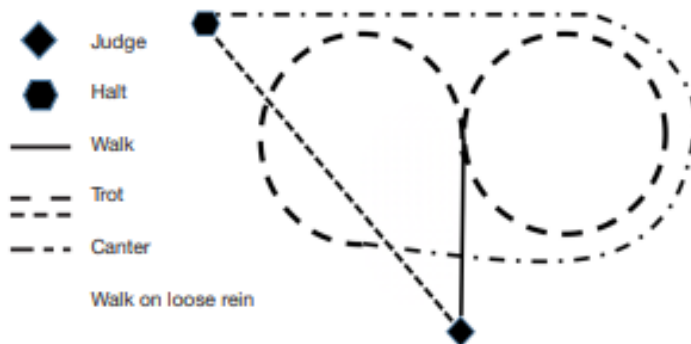
1. Present to the judge for inspection of presentation.
2. At judge's signal, move off at walk to the center of the arena.
3. Circle right, working trot.
4. Half circle left, working trot, picking up the left canter in the second half of the circle.
5. Canter around the arena to the left, lengthening canter along the back side.
6. Come down through the gaits to halt.
7. Return to judge on loose rein.
