Rules and Regulations

Ringmaster: Mary-Rose Simmons 03 57953398

For Euroa Agricultural Society general regulations please refer to the general show schedule available from the Secretary on 57951806 or from the Secretaries office on the day of show. Order of judging may be altered at the discretion of the stewards. All competitors and spectators, whether competing or not, do so at their own risk. Competitors are covered for Public Liability.

EFA affiliated: Conducted under EFA rules and regulation. All competitors are reminded that random EFA swabbing may occur.

VAS Ltd. affiliated

Measuring: All horses competing in height classes to bear current height certificate.

Junior Riders: Any rider under the age of 18 years, must wear protective headgear to the current Australian, European or American standard. The restraining harness must be secured and fastened at all times.

Riders under 18 years must wear short boots in riding competitions.

Show Hunters: Show Hunters are quality show animals showing a little more substance and boldness of movement than is required for show horses.

In Rings 1 and 2 horses may only compete as a show horse OR a show hunter in their height class. In Ring 3 height classes are open to show horses and show hunters.

Leading Rein ó Pony 12hh or under, ridden by a child 4 yrs. & under 8 yrs. Handler to be 18 years and over. Snaffle bit must be used. No spurs or whips. A leading rein is attached to the pony's noseband, and is held by the handler in their left hand leaving the right hand free to help the child if needed. Pony will only be required to walk and trot.

It is the pony being judged ó it is not a smartest on parade.

First Ridden ó Pony 12.2hh or under ridden by a child under 12 yrs. Snaffle bit must be used.

Stallions/Colts are not eligible to compete in ridden classes except where specified.

ō**Local**ö - resident within 30 kilometers of Euroa Showgrounds. Proof of eligibility may be required.

“**Intermediate**” is not to have placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in that class at a Royal Show

“**First Season/Newcomer**” For horses, galloways & ponies that have not competed in show horse or show hunter classes under saddle before 1st August 2008

Once a ridden horse has won a Championship in one ring (excluding Best First Season/Newcomer in Ring 3) it is not eligible to compete in its height class in another ring.

Method of judging:

Phase one ó jumping: Each competitor starts with 80 jumping points from which penalties for knock downs, and refusals are deducted. The judge also awards a further mark out of 20 for style and manners during the jumping round, giving a total out of 100 for Phase 1.

Phase two ó showing: The competitor will be asked to do a workout which should include a gallop. The workout will be scored as follows: conformation out of 20, paces/freedom of action out of 20, and manners out of 10, giving a total out of 50 for Phase 2.
