RULES AND REGULATIONS

Entries not to be held by the 16th of January 2002 will not be accepted and will be returned to sender. Please help us to help you long term.

- 1 **NOVICE** Never to have won a blue ribbon completing singly at any agricultural show.
- 2 **INTERMEDIATE** Not to have won a prize competing singly at any Royal Show
- 3 **OPEN** No restriction on a horses performance as long as it comes within the specified rules.
- 4 A Saddle Horse, Calloway or Pony is defined as being three years of age or over.
- 5 Local events are for people who live within a 20 km radius of the Maryborough Post Office.
- 6 The program will be conducted in accordance with EFA Saddle Horse Judges and Competition rules. (Effective 1/8/86)
- 7 A horse winning champion is then ineligible to compete in the other ring. Rings 1 and 2 only
- 8 All Stallions / Colts must be lead or ridden by an Adult 18 years or over.
- 9 Height measurement obtained at the Royal Melbourne Show or at an Official EFA measuring days and recorded on EFA registration papers is the only height valid for the current season. Horses must be shown at their recorded height.
- 10 Names of horses must be given at the time of entry. In riding events the name of the rider must be given
- 11 Under no circumstance will any ring be held up.
- 12 Dual registered Ponies with APFB and Welsh Pony or Cob Society of Australia are eligible for only one of the other section on the day.
- 13 Registered bred entries must be accompanied with a photo copy current papers.
- 14 Owners entering these classes must also send a photo copy of current membership card and be financial at that time.
- 15 "Gazelle Butterworth" (Perpetual Trophy) For Turmount Riders under 21 yrs.
Horses and Riders to Ride within a 20 km Radius of the Maryborough Post Office.
Point Score system is as follows: Riding ability 30 points, Manners and Pacers 30 points, Cleanliness of Horse, Saddle and Costume 20 points, General Appearance 20 points.
Perpetual Trophy Ribbons to 3rd place will be awarded.
- 16 All Riders under 18 yrs. must wear approved ASSA Helmet with harness secured at all times in all classes, whether being judged as a Junior or in Open categories.
- 17 Top Boots may not be worn by riders under 18 years in riding competitions but may be worn in other classes.
- 18 A Definite Launch Break will be taken between 12 and 1PM.
- 19 Stewards must not be asked to alter ring books for any reason.
- 20 Competitors if your name is not in the book then it is deemed that you have not entered.
- 21 Those wishing gate entry on a membership card must produce the same.
- 22 Rings will not be held up for any reason and but all cars will be taken not to clash classes
- 23 Persons entering in Standard Breed Harness classes in Calours must also wear the matching scull cap.
- 24 Persons entering in Harness classes using score then one horse per vehicle must have the other horses on the ring with harness and handler. Failure to have the horse in line before the class has been judged will see those persons disqualified.
- 25 Ring books must not be altered. Your name must be in the book prior to the event.
