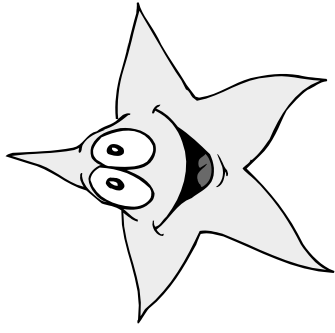

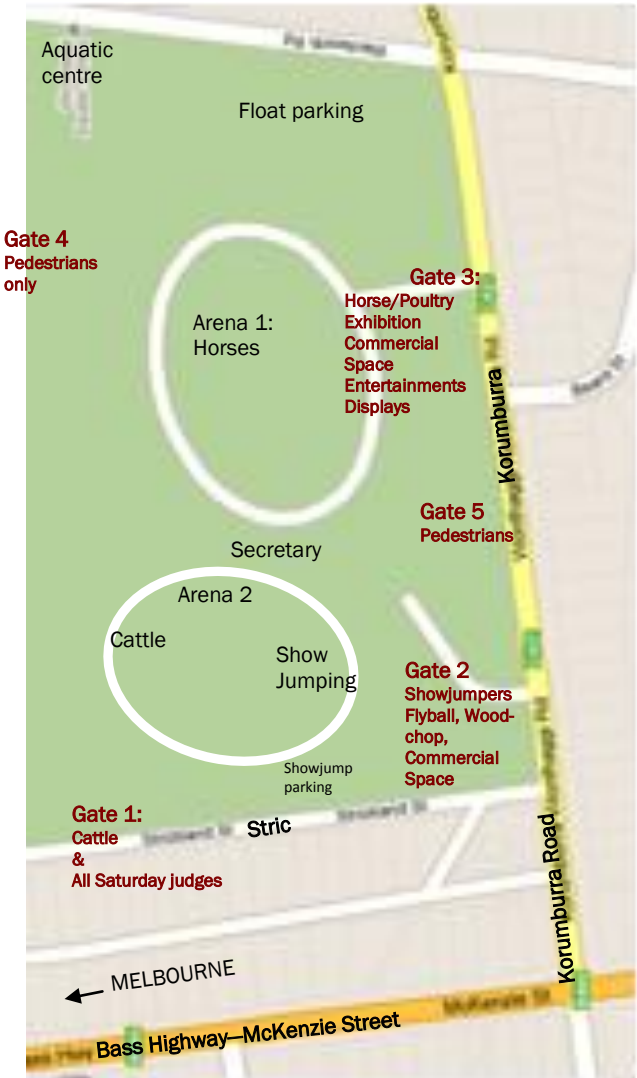

MAP OF SHOWGROUNDS



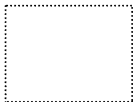
